RIVIERA (FR) was unhurried early outside of rivals, angled in entering the turn and saved ground to the three eighths pole, swung six wide entering stretch and assumed command just outside of the eighth pole; then held off ARKADIAN HERO under strong urging. ARKADIAN HERO dwelt at the start and spotted the field eight lengths, was allowed to settle and saved ground to the stretch, angled out with a quarter mile to run and drew even in the final strides, but could not get by. AFFIRMED SUCCESS was allowed to settle just off the rail, saved ground through the turn, then angled out in upper stretch and closed willingly four wide. LADIES DIN was void of early speed, roused four wide on the turn and rallied well off the rail in the drive. MULTATHIR (GB) was close up just off the rail, closed the gap and drew even entering the stretch, but did not have enough to stay with the leaders in the final furlong. THINK RED was allowed to settle just off the rail, was in tight at the quarter pole, but lacked a strong response in the late going. HONEST LADY was void of early speed inside of rivals, made a mild bid entering the stretch, but flattened out in the final furlong. HELOTROPE pressed the early pace inside of KAHAL (GB), then tired in the stretch and dropped back. CRACKER'S FOLLY was untroubled early just off the rail, roused entering the stretch and finished with a mild bid inside of rivals, but was never a threat. SOLITARY DANCER stalked the early pace three wide, was in tight at the quarter pole and lacked a late response. KAHAL (GB) showed good early speed and duelled just off the rail, then tired in the stretch. VALID N BOLD raced close up in the early going well off the rail, then dropped back on the turn. DAWSON'S LEGACY was in hand on a short lead, but, stopped in upper stretch and faded to last.

WILLIAMS NEWS was unhurried for six furlongs while saving ground, angled four wide while gaining on the turn, made a run to threaten in upper stretch, overtook the winner to gain a slim lead in deep stretch then lost the bob. DALIAPOUR (IRE) stalked the early leader while three wide, raced just off the pace from outside to the turn, gained a slim lead at the top of the stretch, remained a factor into mid stretch then weakened in the final eighth. CAITANO (GB) raced well back for seven furlongs before breaking slowly, rapidly gained while three wide on the turn, angled to the inside in upper stretch then finished willingly while lugging in slightly through the lane. RIVER BOAT, unhurried early, gained a bit while three wide on the turn and improved his position with a mild late rally. MURGHEM (IRE) chased the leaders along the inside for a mile and gradually tired thereafter. LYCITUS (IRE) raced well back while saving ground to the turn. FREE VACATION set a strong closing bid. FREE VACATION set or forced the pace between horses to the turn and tired. TAPPAT void of early speed, lodged a mild rally five wide on the turn and flattened out. BAD RIVER failed to menace while saving ground. I AND I never reached contention. DAWSON'S LEGACY set the pace along the inside for a mile and gave way.

INNUENDO (IRE) stalked the early pace outside of LADY AT PEACE, drew even between horses in upper stretch and gained a short lead with a furlong to go, but weakened slightly at the wire. ALEXIS (IRE) was unhurried early along the rail, closed the gap entering the stretch, was boxed in and steadied just outside of the eighth pole then dropped back. LADY AT PEACE was well rated on a clear lead in the early going then faltered in the drive and gave way. MELODY QUEEN (GB) was well rated inside of rivals in the early going, closed the gap entering the stretch, was in tight and steadied, continued along the rail through the drive then was steadied again in deep stretch.
