GOOD JOURNEY was allowed to settle just off the rail outside of DUMAANI STAR in the early going, raced three wide on the turn, entered the stretch four wide and wore down the early leader CHOPININA under a hand ride. The latter sped to the early lead in hand and opened a clear advantage on the turn, continued strong in the drive and was all out in the final furlong, gave way in the late going, but battled gamely and held place. NUCLEAR DEBATE was in hand along the rail, continued saving ground on the turn, but was boxed in and steadied, then angled to the outside in the drive and finished well. MOON SOLITAIRE (IRE) stalked the early pace three wide, continued three wide on the turn and finished evenly. TOUCH OF THE BLUES (FR) was allowed to settle well off the rail inside of rivals, rallied on the turn while saving ground, loomed boldly in the drive, but was checked hard approaching the wire. NOVERRE broke sharply and was taken back in the early going, raced four wide on the turn and finished with a mild rally. STRUT THE STAGE was slow early just off the rail, swung wide in upper stretch and rallied belatedly well off the rail. KRIEGER was close up inside of rivals, then faded in the stretch. DUMAANI STAR ran rank in the early going along the rail, continued saving ground on the turn and lacked a late response. DEL MAR SHOW was allowed to settle between horses, roused three wide in the stretch, but was never a threat. QUIET RESOLVE was void of early speed three wide and never rallied. AUTONOMY (IRE) was allowed to settle inside of rivals and never rallied. REGAL MISTER broke sharply and pressed the early pace outside of CHOPININA, then faded quickly in the stretch. Following the race the jockey of TOUCH OF THE BLUES (FR) lodged a claim of foul against the jockey of CHOPININA for possible interference approaching the wire. After reviewing the tapes the Stewards ruled that there was no infraction and the order of finish was unchanged.

BALLINGARRY (IRE) was allowed to settle just behind the early leader YAVANA'S PACE (IRE), drew even outside of that one on the second turn and made a mid bid, but flattened out in the drive. PORTCULLIS was drawn clear under steady pressure. FALCON FLIGHT (FR) was allowed to settle inside of rivals in the early going, in tight 3/8 pole, edged off the rail and roused entering the stretch, came outside of the leader in the drive and finished well, but was second best. YAVANA'S PACE (IRE) broke a bit slowly but was rushed to the early lead, then settled into a good stride and set the early pace in hand along the rail, duelled briefly inside of the winner on the second turn, but weakened in the drive. PERFECT SOUL (IRE) was taken back and allowed to settle well off the lead along the rail, swung outside of rivals on the turn and rallied belatedly in the three path. ZINDABAD (FR) was allowed to settle in the two path, then roused three wide on the second turn and made a mid bid three wide, but was never a threat. PAOLINI (GER) was off slowly and well rated inside of rivals, moved between horses on the second turn and made a mid bid, but flattened out in the drive. PORTCULLIS was allowed to settle in the two path and failed to respond when asked. FULL OF WONDER was void of early speed three wide and never a factor.

ALASHA (IRE) was allowed to settle three wide outside of rivals in the early going, closed the gap outside of VOLGA (IRE) exiting the final turn, continued outside of rivals in the drive and finished well four wide, but could not close any ground on the winner. VOLGA (IRE) stalked the early pace from the three path, then dropped back slightly on the second turn on the gap again at the three eighths pole and came three wide between horses in the drive finishing with a mild rally. CHOC ICE (IRE) was in hand trailing the field in the early going, angled to the outside in the drive, but could not close any ground. NADIA (GB) set a slow pace just off the rail in the early going, duelled outside of the winner on the second turn, then weakened in the stretch and dropped back. INISH GLORA was well rated inside of rivals stalking the early pace, but lacked late response and was never a threat.

CAPTAIN WALLSTREET dueled for the early lead along the rail, then faltered at the approaching the far turn and faded quickly.
